HISTORY OF OAKLAND COUNTY EXECUTIVE STRUCTURE

Before 1973, most Michigan counties operated under a General Law form of government, where a county board of commissioners shared executive and legislative functions with other elected and appointed officials.

In 1973, Public Act 139 introduced the Optional Unified Form of County Government, allowing counties to adopt a new structure. This form includes two alternatives: a county board of commissioners sharing executive functions with either an appointed county manager (Unified Form, Alternate A) or an elected county executive (Unified Form, Alternate B). Oakland County was the first to adopt this form in 1974, electing Daniel Murphy as its first county executive. Bay County followed in 1978. Today, Oakland and Bay are the only counties using this system.

Notably, Daniel Murphy's legacy continues in Oakland County, with his daughter Gwen Markham serving on the Board of Commissioners and his son Jerry Murphy on the Oakland County Historical Commission.

The County Executive's responsibilities are similar to those of a governor or mayor of a large city. The executive administers the government on a day-to-day basis, proposes new programs, revamps existing ones, and represents the interests of more than 1.2 million residents.

Under this structure the Board of Commissioners performs a role similar to a state legislature or city council. It acts on proposals submitted by the County Executive and makes proposals of its own. It possesses the legislative and administrative powers granted by state law. The County Executive may veto acts of the Board and the vetoes can be overridden by a two-thirds vote of the Board.

The executive form of government did not change the third branch of government, the judiciary. Similarly, the five other offices headed by officials elected countywide remain unchanged. These are the Oakland County Prosecutor, Sheriff, Clerk/Register of Deeds, Treasurer and Water Resources Commissioner.

Oakland Community Health Network’s (OCHN) mission is to inspire hope, empower people and strengthen communities through public behavioral health services provided to Oakland County residents.

OCHN is contracted by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) to lead a service provider network and manage care for approximately 30,000 Oakland County residents at more than 400 service sites across the county. People who receive public behavioral health services through OCHN's provider network include those who have an intellectual or developmental disability, mental health concerns, or substance use disorder. Most of these individuals have Medicaid insurance coverage.

A full array of behavioral health and community-based services are offered through OCHN’s contracted, service provider network, including evaluation and screening; hospital and residential treatment; respite care; clubhouse and day programs, supported employment; multilingual programs; correction services; and dual diagnosis for individuals with both a mental health and substance use disorder.

OCHN’s goal is to ensure these individuals are aware of and have access to services and support that will improve their health and quality of life, as well as ensure their engagement in full community participation. Its mission to “inspire hope, empower people, and strengthen communities” reflects an unyielding belief in a "Valuable System for Valued People." Programs and supports provided by OCHN's service network are available at oaklandchn.org.

OAKLAND COUNTY PARKS



This year Oakland County Parks (OCP) celebrates its 60th Anniversary. Over the past six decades, OCP has been dedicated to creating and operating accessible, welcoming and sustainable parks and public spaces; providing recreational and educational programming; preserving open green spaces; and building healthy, connected communities in Oakland County. Ninety percent of residents live within a 10-drive of an Oakland County Park, including partnership parks and facilities.

The parks system was first established in 1966 and has since played an important role in the lives of Oakland County residents. Generations of park visitors have enjoyed family camping trips, hiking the trails, nature programming, golf outings and hot summer days at the waterpark or beach.

Originally, OCP began with 200 acres. Today, the parks system boasts more than 7,000 acres, including more than 100 miles of trails and 17 parks that align with the mission to provide equitable access, conservation, recreation and health and wellness benefits to the community. OCP offers a variety of recreation, leisure and learning opportunities at two nature centers, three dog parks, five golf courses, two campgrounds, a waterpark, an ORV park and the Oakland County Farmers Market, which offers fresh produce and products from local farmers and artisans year-round.



OAKLAND COUNTY PARKS

Oakland County residents have supported the maintenance and growth of the parks system by approving every millage vote since 1966.

Over the past year, significant developments have included:

- Renovating park features to enhance the guest experience, including expanding the disc golf course at Pontiac Oaks Park to 18-holes and updating the platform tennis courts and surrounding area at Waterford Oaks County Park to create “Cattail Cove”.
- Creating new community partnerships with the City of Rochester Hills to establish Clinton River Oaks, a 235-acre park stretching along 2.5 miles of the Clinton River, Waterford School District to open 79.5 acres of school-owned land for public park use, and the City of Farmington Hills to invest in Heritage Oaks, a 211-acre park known for its hiking trails, nature center, splash pad, historic buildings and more.
- Integrating Michigan State University Extension (MSUE) with Oakland County Parks, combining the research, education and outreach strengths of MSUE with the public spaces, programs and community reach of OCP.
- Marking the induction of Independence Oaks County Park and Addison Oaks County Park & Campground into the Old-Growth Forest Network. Independence Oaks was recognized for having 14 acres of true old-growth conditions and Addison Oaks was inducted into the Network as a Community Forest.
- Opening 40 additional acres of scramble area to drivers at Holly Oaks ORV Park, providing a total of 215 acres for off-roading activities.
- Celebrating the end of the season with Glow-Bye Summer, a new, glowing community event held at Friendship Park and making the most of winter with the first-ever Fireworks and Flannels event held at Waterford Oaks.
- Providing more than 400 Mobile Recreation visits through the Recreation Assistance Partnership Program (RAPP), serving 56 local communities.
- Distributing a total of 18,540 native plants over three community events and collecting 48 gallons of milkweed seed pods for milkweed restoration projects.

ADDISON OAKS COUNTY PARK & CAMPGROUND

1480 W. Romeo Road, Leonard (248) 693-2432

This 1,140-acre natural oasis offers camping, boating, picnicking, fishing, a Solar System Trail and more. It features an 18-hole disc golf course and a 20-mile system of trails for hiking, mountain or fat tire biking, cross-country skiing and equestrian use. The campground offers individual and group sites, rental cabins and yurts, and campground recreation activities. The historic, Tudor-style Buhl Estate, located in the park, is perfect for weddings, banquets, reunions, receptions and more.

CATALPA OAKS COUNTY PARK

27705 Greenfield Road, Southfield (248) 424-7040

Catalpa Oaks preserves 24 acres of green space in Southfield adjacent to the South Oakland Health Department. The park features one youth and four large soccer fields and playgrounds, including a universally-accessible playscape and swings for all abilities. A .8-mile aggregate perimeter pathway around the park provides a walking and running loop. The Vincent Gregory Pavilion offers picnic table seating for 100 people. Modern restrooms are on site and open daily April through October.

CLINTON RIVER OAKS PARK

1991 E. Avon Road, Rochester Hills. (248) 858-0906

Clinton River Oaks Park is a new 235-acre county park that will expand equitable recreational access, preserve natural resources and promote public health in the Rochester and Rochester Hills communities. Running along 2.5 miles of the Clinton River, it will provide numerous opportunities for recreation, conservation and community connection by anchoring trails, waterways and public lands in one of Michigan’s most scenic and historic corridors. An interlocal agreement with the City of Rochester Hills brought a 108-acre parcel in Bloomer Park’s northern section and the Yates Park area under Oakland County Park and Recreation’s management in February 2026. In addition, OCP will acquire 128 acres of undeveloped riverfront property adjacent to Bloomer Park and the Clinton River Trail while continuing to explore opportunities with the City of Rochester to expand access and connectivity along the Clinton River corridor.

GLEN OAKS GOLF COURSE

30500 13 Mile Road, Farmington Hills (248) 851-8356

This picturesque, 18-hole, par 70 course includes a 1920s English-style stone clubhouse with a club room, event center and outdoor patio. The clubhouse also offers a pro shop. A formal garden on the grounds is ideal for outdoor weddings and other special occasions.

GROVELAND OAKS COUNTY PARK & CAMPGROUND

14555 Dixie Highway, Holly. (248) 634-9811

This 360-acre park and campground on Stewart Lake features a sandy beach with swimming, fishing, boating and pedal boating. It also has three large children’s playscapes, a camp store, miniature golf, campground recreation program, shuffleboard court, bocce ball court,

skateboard park, bike skills course, gaga pit, arcade, basketball and volleyball courts and paved trails. Pedal boats, kayaks and bikes are available to rent. Campers have a choice of modern, individual or group campsites, rental cabins and yurts.

HIGHLAND OAKS COUNTY PARK NATURE AREA

6555 Milford Road, Highland(248) 599-2708

Located within the headwaters of the Shiawassee River headwaters, this 302-acre park preserves sensitive habitat while providing excellent recreational experiences in a beautiful natural setting among rolling hills, wetlands and pastures. It has 2.5 miles of multi-purpose trails that provide an opportunity for hiking, geocaching, cross-country skiing and equestrian activities. Fishing is also permitted on the accessible floating dock.

HOLLY OAKS ORV PARK

14551 Shields Road, Holly(248) 881-3821

Consisting of former active sand and gravel mines, this park is located off I-75 at the Grange Hall Road exit and Dixie Highway, near Groveland Oaks County Park & Campground. Criss-crossed by old mining trails, it features extreme terrain, ranging from mud flats to 40’ vertical cliffs and is open to all types of ORVs, including full-size vehicles, side-by-sides, ATVs and motorcycles. The “North 60” is a “scramble area” in which riders are free to make their own paths. There is a daily entry fee, and an ORV license and trail permit are required. This park is a joint state-county project operated by OCP in partnership with the Michigan Department of Natural Resources (MDNR).

INDEPENDENCE OAKS - NORTHY COUNTY PARK NATURE AREA

9501 Sashabaw Road, Clarkston(248) 625-0877

This 1,286-acre park – the largest in the Oakland County Parks system – features year-round recreation with more than 12 miles of trails for hiking, biking and cross-country skiing. The 68-acre Crooked Lake provides fishing and boating opportunities. Swimming is available at Hidden Beach. Guests can enjoy the archery range, picnic areas, rental shelters, court games and playground equipment. Wint Nature Center provides year-round education programs presented by park naturalists. It features an outdoor sensory garden as well as a bird feeding station and natural viewing area. Camp Wilderness, a 10-acre primitive campground, offers camping experiences to youth groups and features platform tents, pavilion, a fire circle, a modern bathhouse, picnic tables, charcoal grills and access to park amenities.

INDEPENDENCE OAKS - NORTH NATURE PARK

This park features a 312-foot boardwalk connecting to a 180-foot-long fishing dock. It is a destination for fishing, hiking, birdwatching and non-motorized boating. Anglers can launch canoes, kayaks or other non-motorized boats. Upper Bushman Lake is catch-and-release only as designated by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources (MDNR).



OAKLAND COUNTY PARKS

LYON OAKS COUNTY PARK & GOLF COURSE

52221 Pontiac Trail, Wixom (248) 437-1488

This park preserves 800 acres of environmentally sensitive wetlands within its 1,041 acres. It features an Arthur Hills-designed 18-hole championship golf course with a driving range and elegant event facilities. The day-use area has a picnic shelter and playground, pickleball courts, volleyball, horseshoes pits, soccer fields and a cricket pitch. There are six miles of trails for biking, on-leash dog walking and cross-country skiing. Dogs can play off-leash at the popular 13-acre, fenced Lyon Oaks Dog Park.

ORION OAKS COUNTY PARK & ORION OAKS DOG PARK

1200 Joslyn Road, Orion.(248) 625-0877

More than 916 acres of environmentally sensitive green space is preserved within this park, which offers boating and fishing on the 90-acre Lake Sixteen, as well as 10 miles of trails for hiking, biking and cross-country skiing. A wheelchair accessible fishing dock and 120-foot boardwalk links two trail systems. The 24-acre Orion Oaks Dog Park features enclosures for off-leash play, two trails, fields, picnic pavilion and modern restrooms.

PONTIAC OAKS PARK

1400 Telegraph Road, Pontiac(248) 858-0906

Formerly known as Hawthorne Park, this park preserves 77 acres of green space and features the shorelines of Creger Lake and Upper Silver Lake with water access for kayaking, canoeing and fishing provided through an accessible fishing dock and boat launch. The park also offers a playground, pavilion, horseshoes pits, picnic area and an 18-hole disc golf course. OCP collaborated with The City of Pontiac to assume operations of the park, while the city retains ownership.

RED OAKS COUNTY PARK

Multiple addresses in Madison Heights(248) 585-0100

This 163-acre park, which sits atop the enclosed George W. Kuhn Drain, is a unique example of repurposing urban land for recreational use. It features a dog park, golf course, nature center and waterpark. Red Oaks Dog Park at 31353 Dequindre Road, offers more than five acres with three fenced enclosures, a small-dog area and a picnic shelter. At Red Oaks Golf Course, 29600 John R. Road, golfers can enjoy a 9-hole, Jerry Matthews-designed course that also offers warm-up hitting nets. Red Oaks Waterpark, 1455 E. 13 Mile Road, offers fun for all ages with a wave-action pool, triple-flume waterslide, river ride and children’s splashpad with 52 interactive water features, including a water play climber with slides and dumping bucket. Red Oaks Nature Center, 30300 Hales St., features interpretive nature and live animal exhibits, interactive displays, a sensory trail and a storybook trail. It also provides opportunities for field trips, birthday parties, homeschool programs and more.



OAKLAND COUNTY PARKS

ROSE OAKS COUNTY PARK NATURE AREA

10501 Buckhorn Lake Road, Holly (248) 599-2708

Several glacier lakes within this nearly 650-acre undeveloped park provide contrast to the gently rolling meadows and wooded uplands. The park is a favorite of equestrians who explore its five miles of trails, including accessible boardwalks and floating docks, which are also shared by hikers, cyclists, geocachers and cross-country skiers. Fishing is permitted and non-motorized boats and electric motorboats are allowed; carry-in only.

SPRINGFIELD OAKS COUNTY PARK & GOLF COURSE

12451 Andersonville Road, Davisburg (248) 599-2708

This 332-acre park includes an 18-hole golf course that is conveniently located just north of Clarkston. A multi-purpose event center hosts banquets, receptions and 4-H events. The park is also home to the historic Ellis Barn, which is a popular site for weddings, and home to the annual Oakland County Fair, which draws more than 100,000 visitors to the 10-day event each year.

WATERFORD OAKS COUNTY PARK

Multiple addresses in Waterford (248) 858-0916

Headquarters of the Oakland County Parks and Recreation Commission at 2800 Watkins Lake Road, 199-acre Waterford Oaks is also home to more than three miles of hiking trails; a universally accessible playscape; two platform tennis and year-round pickleball courts; the world-class Waterford Oaks Bicycle Motocross (BMX) Track; sand volleyball courts; a winter family sledding hill; and outdoor fitness equipment. Lookout Lodge, Waterford Oaks Event Center and picnic shelters are available for rent. The Oakland County Farmers Market, at 2350 Pontiac Lake Road, provides grower-direct produce, fresh flowers and artisan goods year-round.

WHITE LAKE OAKS GOLF COURSE

991 Williams Lake Road, White Lake (248) 698-2700

This scenic, 18-hole, par 70 course includes 194 acres that feature woodlands and wetlands. It also has a pro shop, club room and garden patio. The White Lake Oaks Event Center, which overlooks the golf course and has the capacity for approximately 180 people, is available for rent.



OAKLAND COUNTY ROADS

Almost half the highways, roads, and streets in Oakland County are part of the county system, which is under the jurisdiction of the Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC).

Totaling more than 2,700 miles, RCOC’s road system includes all public roads in townships, except state highways, and some through-streets in most cities and villages. It is the largest county system in Michigan, second in size only to the state highway system. Subdivision streets in the townships alone make up more than 1,300 miles.

In 1992, RCOC embarked on a program called FAST-TRAC, an Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) effort. The Road Commission has installed “smart” traffic signals operated by computers and video vehicle detection at more than 850 intersections across the county. This is one of the largest and most advanced adaptive traffic control systems in the United States and the largest video imaging system for traffic management in the world. The Road Commission was the first local unit of government to initiate a program of this scope and magnitude.

For paving and resurfacing of subdivision streets, property owners can petition RCOC to create a special assessment district through a process prescribed by state law. The process begins by contacting the Road Commission, then petitioning and participating in public hearings.

The Board of Road Commissioners is separate from county general government – establishing policies as authorized by state statutes for management of the countywide road system, administering its own budget and hiring its own full-time managing director and staff.

Citizen requests for information are given special attention by the Road Commission’s Department of Customer Services (DCS).
