

3D ARCHERY RANGE RULES



General Rules:

- Shooting only permitted when staff is onsite
- Children under 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Only paid participants are permitted on the 3D archery course.
- Spectators are not allowed.
- Participants must be 8 years of age or older.
- Equipment that can be used on the range:
 - Long Bows
 - Recurve Bows
 - Compound Bows
- Field points only – No broadheads permitted.
- **NO CROSSBOWS ALLOWED**
- Be considerate of fellow shooters
- Obey all posted signs and staff instructions
- Shoot from designated stations
- Shoot towards designated targets only.
- Maximum of 4 archers per group
- One archer at a time on the shooting line.
- Maximum 2 arrows per target per shooter.
- Do not nock or draw your bow until it is your turn to shoot.
- All archers must stand behind the safety line when not shooting
- Only nock arrows at the shooting line and only point arrows toward designated target
- Always draw a bow with the arrow pointed down range
- Each shooter has one minute at stake. Please allow faster groups to shoot through
- Stop shooting immediately if someone enters a shooting lane.
- Three minute limit to look for lost arrows
- Do not advance to retrieve arrows until the lane is clear.
- **Do not go outside of designated shooting lanes when retrieving arrows**
- All archers must retrieve their arrows at the same time
- Do not move or tamper with targets or course layout.
- Stay on designated trails, No backtracking
- Under no circumstances should an arrow be shot anywhere other than toward the target
- No pets on the course.
- No alcohol permitted
- Respect wildlife and the natural environment.
- Dispose of trash in provided containers or pack it out.
