**MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION GRANT CONTRACT FOR
FEDERAL/STATE AIRPORT DEVELOPMENT: ACQUIRE EASEMENT (LAND
OAKLAND/SOUTHWEST AIRPORT**

The County is in receipt of a Michigan Department of Transportation Grant Contract No. 3-26-0118-28826 for federal funds in the amount of \$193,876 and state funds in the amount of \$10,206 to Acquire Easement for Approaches-08 (E12-E14, E16, E20-21, E39 for land – Environmental at Oakland/Southwest Airport. There is no local share. The contract provides that MDOT-Bureau of Aeronautics shall act as agent on behalf of the County in the administration of the project.

Taylor moved approval of MDOT-Bureau of Aeronautics grant contract, No. 3-26-0118-28826, subject to ratification by the Oakland County Board of Commissioners. Seconded by Joliat.

**MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION GRANT CONTRACT FOR
STATE/LOCAL AIRPORT DEVELOPMENT: CLEAN/REHABILITATE
FUEL/WATER SEPARATOR - CONSTRUCTION**

The County is in receipt of a Michigan Department of Transportation Grant Contract No. 2026-0664 for state funds in the amount of \$86,843 to Clean/Rehabilitate Fuel/Water Separator. There is no local match.

VanderVeen moved approval of MDOT-Bureau of Aeronautics Grant Contract No. 2026-0664 subject to ratification by the Oakland County Board of Commissioners. Seconded by Joliat.

**MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, GREAT LAKES, AND ENERGY
(EGLE) PFAS AIRPORT GRANT AGREEMENT WITH OAKLAND COUNTY
INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (OCIA)**

The County is in receipt of Michigan Department of Environment Great Lakes and Energy (EGLE) Remediation and Redevelopment Division (State) Grant in the amount of \$327,660 for PFAS Response Activities at Oakland County International Airport (OCIA). There is no local match required.

Taylor moved approval of the PFAS Airport Grant Agreement between EGLE Remediation and Redevelopment Division (State) and Oakland County subject to ratification by the Oakland County Board of Commissioners. Seconded by Joliat.

Motion carried unanimously on a voice vote.

Update on the proposed development in Lyon Township adjacent to Oakland/Southwest was discussed and Bush has an upcoming meeting on August 11, 2026 with Oakland County leadership and the developer to discuss the pond issue.
