CCSW HOURS MUST BE DONE IN PERSON UNDER SUPERVISION AT AN AGENCY (NOT THROUGH AN ONLINE AGENCY)

1. Your Community Service Work must be completed and verified.
By: _____. PLEASE INITIAL AND DATE: _____.
2. You are to keep track of your hours, along with your Supervisor. To avoid miscounted hours, be sure to sign in and out every time you do Community Service at your agency.
3. Credit will only be given for work that is completed to the agency's satisfaction.
4. After your hours are completed, you must obtain a letter of verification on the agency's letterhead stationary. The letter **MUST** be signed by your supervisor, include number of hours worked, time period in which the hours have been completed, and a daytime telephone number of the person who signed your letter. (*Your Probation Officer will be calling to verify your Community Service work.*)

NO CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN UNLESS THE CCSW IS PROPERLY VERIFIED

5. Community Service must be done at a non-profit agency. No credit will be given if the agency does not have a **501 (C)(3) Tax Identification Number**.
6. Community Service must be done in person, online Community Service will not be accepted.

COURT COMMUNITY SERVICE WORK IS NOT LIMITED TO THE LIST OF AGENCIES PROVIDED IN THIS PACKET. WORK MAY BE DONE AT ANY NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION; HOWEVER, YOUR PROBATION OFFICER MUST APPROVE ANY AGENCY THAT IS NOT LISTED.
